Help maintain this natural oasis:

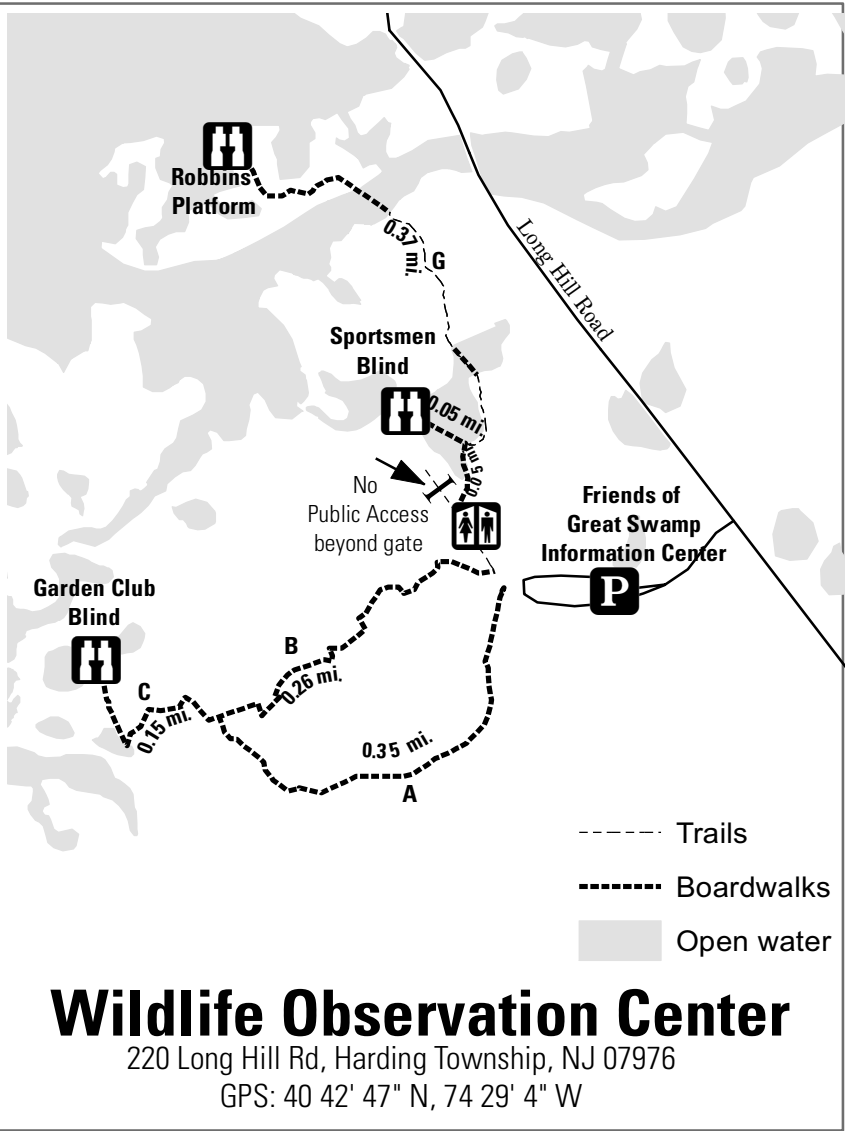
- *Public access is restricted to designated trails (except within the Wilderness Area east of Long Hill Road.)*
- *Pets must be leashed and are allowed ONLY on Pleasant Plains Road and on the turf lawn at the Visitor Center. Service animals are always welcome.*
- *Bicycles are allowed only on Pleasant Plains Road and in parking areas.*



To help preserve the refuge, protect wildlife and ensure a quality visit for yourself and others, the following are prohibited:

- *Collecting plants, animals or parts thereof (dead or alive)*
- *Releasing any animals or dumping any plant material*
- *Littering*
- *Fishing*
- *Hunting (except by special refuge permit)*
- *Use of drones*

A full account of refuge regulations may be found in Title 50 Code of Federal Regulations, sections 25-32.
